MEMBERSHIP GRADES RULES

General

Grades of membership of the Institute are available to those who have achieved recognized levels of academic and experience and/or made contributions to the transport profession in accordance with the Membership Grades Rules of the Institute. Depending on their respective levels of achievement, applicants will be eligible for one of the five grades of membership, of which three are of the Corporate Grades and two are the Non-Corporate Grades. These grades are:

Corporate Grades

Fellow

Full Member

Associate Member

Non-Corporate Grades

Associate

Student

Fellow

A full member who

- has worked at a senior level in the transport or related industries for a least five years;
or
- has made major contribution to the transport industry, transport academia, logistics trainings or the Institute; and
- has received the recommendation of the Membership Sub-Committee of the Institute.

Member

A person who

- has met or has been fully exempted from the academic requirements of the Institute; and
- with a minimum of three years of professional experience at the supervisory level in traffic, transport or relevant profession sector; and
- has received the recommendation of the Membership Sub-Committee of the Institute.

Associate Member

A person who has:

- meet the academic requirements for Full Member but has no working experience

or

- shall be over 21 years of age;
- was a Student Member of the Institute;
- has completed transport related training at level of diploma or above;
- possesses 2 years of above experience in the transport or related industry; and
- has received the approval of the Membership Sub-Committee of the Institute.

Associate

A person who:

- shall be over 18 years of age;
- has been a Student Member of the Institute;
- has completed transport related training at diploma and above level; and
- is preparing to join the transport or a related industry.

A person who does not hold the level of academic qualification may still apply and his application will be considered on a case to case basis depending upon his academic qualification, current employment and reference provided.

Student

A person who:

- is a student pursuing secondary education at Form 3 or above level;
- is a full time / part time student pursuing a diploma level of education; or
- is a student pursuing a program at a post secondary level of education

and

- is recommended by a Full Member of the Institute and has received the recommendation of the Membership Sub-Committee of the Institute.

A Student Member is exempted from payment of membership subscription.
